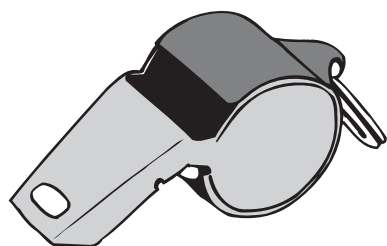


Level 2 General Principles of Coaching



Lecture based course

The key to sport development is coach education. The National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS) is a progressive coach education program. It offers opportunities for coaches to acquire a greater knowledge of coaching that will enable the continued development of our sporting talent.

Level 2 General Principles of Coaching*

Coaches must have their Level 1 accreditation with at least 12 months coaching experience.

To successfully complete this course, participants must:

- Attend all three days of lectures
- Do some home study
- Complete sections of the workbook and submit for assessment.

This course aims to develop practical coaching knowledge and skills for the intermediate coach. The text *Better Coaching – Advanced Coach's Manual and Workbook* will be used, with mention of a variety of other recommended texts throughout the course.

The Level 2 coaching principles component, combined with the sport specific component plus practical coaching hours, will provide Level 2 accreditation within the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme.
