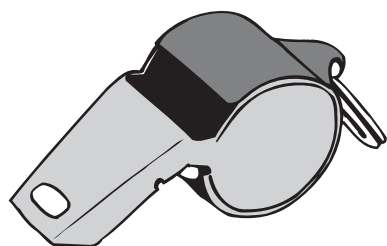


Introduction to officiating course



An official is a person who controls the actual play of a competition by applying the rules and laws of the sport to make judgments on rule infringement, performance, time and score.

There is a high demand for more officials in every sport from grassroots level through to the elite. All you need is an interest in sport and a willingness to be involved. Importantly, officials play a key role in ensuring the spirit of the game/event is observed.

This course sets a minimum standard for all officials from sports involved in the National Officiating Accreditation Scheme (NOAS).

To successfully complete this course you must:

- Attend all lectures
- Complete worksheets and submit them for assessment.

The course is designed to develop knowledge and skills for newcomers to officiating – the text *Introductory Level Officiating Principles* is used.

To gain accreditation as an official with your sport you should contact your State Sporting Association. They will let you know the sport specific requirements for accreditation that complement this course (eg. practical skills, knowledge and field mentoring/assessment).

Privacy statement

The NSW Department of the Arts, Sport and Recreation of 6, Figtree Drive, Sydney Olympic Park, NSW 2127 will collect and store the information you provide to enable processing of enrolments for the Introduction to officiating course. The information will be provided to instructors of the program and their supervisors, where necessary, and you consent to this disclosure. If you have been asked for information regarding Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent and cultural background, this information is voluntary and is being compiled for statistical purposes only. Any information provided by you will be stored on a database that will only be accessed by authorised personnel and is subject to privacy restrictions. The information will only be used for the purpose for which it was collected. Any information provided by you to the department can be accessed by you during standard office hours and updated by writing to us or by contacting us on 13 13 02.

Refunds and cancellations

Requests for refunds must be made within seven (7) working days prior to the commencement of the program in which you are enrolled. All requests must be made in writing. All refunds are subject to an administration fee of 20 per cent of the total program fee. Refunds will not be given for partial attendance, nor will make up lessons be provided. Refunds will be paid at the completion of the program. NSW Sport and Recreation reserves the right to cancel any program/s. Every effort will be made to give reasonable notice to those who have enrolled when a program is cancelled. Those enrolled will be given a full refund.
